To celebrate this, and some changes that have taken place (see below), we are writing this to help re-launch and strengthen our work.

- * A new group of trustees are in place (Sara Barrie from Headingley Street Angels, Trevor Bendrien from Halifax Street Angels, Steve Brock from Stockton Town Pastors, Andy Burns from Street Chaplains Dundee and Major Paul McNally from the Salvation Army) and they are supported by an increasing number of Regional Leaders (see www.cninetwork.org.uk for details).
- * Adam May is moving away from CNI and is set to work on a new initiative with another organisation we are sure you join us in thanking him for all he has done to develop our work and wish him well in his new career and also as a Dad (Becky is expecting in September...)
- * Paul is stepping back from Halifax Street Angels in order to work full time on CNI Network. Since last December, 22 new projects have fully or part launched and there is an increase in the work and potential work across the five strands a full time worker will enable this to happen.

CNI Network is committed to partnering with God, volunteers, local projects, partners and others to help make the difference in community after community. With over 100 local projects in England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland, Isle of Man, Europe and Australia, CNI is a great way of speaking as one voice for those engaged within the night-time economy.
